**BYLAW 02/2006**

***BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 18/2001, BEING A BYLAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES RESCIND BYLAW 06/2002, BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 18/2001.***

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Bowden wishes to establish a fire service within the Municipality and to provide for efficient operation of such a fire service, all pursuant to the laws of the province of Alberta;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council for the Town of Bowden in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enact as follows:

1. Schedule "A" of Bylaw 18/2001 is amended as follows:

**Schedule "A"**

**Fire Protection Charges**

1. Pumper #1 (County)	\$400.00 per hour
Pumper #2	\$400.00 per hour
Tanker #5	\$400.00 per hour
Rescue Vehicle #6	\$300.00 per hour (Responded but NOT used) \$400.00 per hour (Responded AND used);
Rapid Response Vehicle #7	\$300.00 per hour (Responded but NOT used) \$400.00 per hour (Responded AND used)
Fire Fighting Foam	\$500.00 per pail used
Fire Extinguisher	\$125.00 per extinguisher used

2. Bylaw 06/2002 is hereby rescinded.
3. This Bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading.
