Calling ahead to the Red Deer County office and making an appointment is the best way to ensure same day service. Currently the County office accepts cheque, money order, cash or debit when paying for permits.

Directions to the Red Deer County Office from Bowden are as follows:

Travel North on the QE2 until the 32nd Street overpass exit (Red Deer) and head west; the Red Deer County Centre is located behind the Crossroads Church which is clearly visible from Highway 2.

There is a drop box located beside the main doors if anyone wants to drop off applications outside of their business hours of 8:30 – 4:30 Monday to Friday. They are closed during statutory holidays.
